**Traffic Court information**

**Due to the shelter in place in effect for San Mateo County for the foreseeable future, the traffic court is closed for all purposes**

**Currently scheduled cases:**

- If your scheduled hearing is for arraignment on a citation you received, the court will mail you a new arraignment date. If you have an attorney, the court will mail the same information to your attorney.
- If your scheduled hearing is for a court trial on a citation you received, the court will mail you a new trial date. If you have an attorney, the court will mail the same information to your attorney.
- If you elected a trial by written declaration, nothing has changed for you.

**New citations:**

- Once the court has received your citation from the officer, you can go online to pay the fine, or sign up for traffic school if eligible. There is no need to personally appear to do any of those things.
- Currently, you cannot schedule a court date. We are not sure when the court will reopen.
- A reminder notice with a due date for taking action will be mailed to the address on the citation once the court receives it from the officer. If the court is still closed on your due date, please return to this website once a week to ascertain if the court has reopened.
- If the address on your citation is incorrect, please wait until the court has reopened to correct your address.

**ALL:**

Due to the unpredictable nature of this unprecedented quarantine event, your case will not go delinquent, no additional fees will be added, and the DMV will not receive any request to place a hold on your license until a reasonable time after the court is reopened.
