## San Mateo Court Implements Mandatory E-Filing

**Redwood City, CA** – In an effort to continue to improve service to the public and promote sustainability by reducing paper in the courthouse, the San Mateo Superior Court is implementing mandatory electronic filing (e-filing) for some case types, Court Executive Officer Neal Taniguchi announced today.

As of January 21, 2020, San Mateo Superior Court requires that all parties, with the exception of self-represented litigants, electronically file into the following case types:

- Family Law
- Probate

Permissive e-filing is available for the following case types:

- Complex Civil
- Civil
- Small Claims
- Criminal
