AMENDED STANDING ORDER RE
VIDEO RECORDING DEVICES
AND STILL CAMERAS
IN PORTIONS OF THE HALL
OF JUSTICE

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that commencing June 23, 2009 and continuing, no audio recording devices, video recording devices and/or still cameras, excluding cell phones, are to be present on the second, fourth, sixth, seventh or eighth floors of the Hall of Justice and Records. This order is made to ensure the orderly administration of justice and is consistent with prior orders of this Court.

This order does not apply to County of San Mateo offices located on the fourth floor (District Attorney's Office) or the sixth floor (County Counsel's Office) of the Hall of Justice and Records, to persons who are going to or coming from those offices in connection with the business of either of those offices, or to County employees who are providing facilities services at any of the locations specified in this order. To the extent this Order is inconsistent with the Standing Order issued on June 23, 2009, this Order shall take precedence over the June 23, 2009 Order.
