IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that commencing August 30, 2010 and continuing, no audio recording devices, video recording devices and/or still cameras, excluding cell phones, are to be present in the basement or on the second, fourth, sixth, seventh or eighth floors of the Hall of Justice and Records without the express prior approval of the Presiding Judge. This order is made to ensure the orderly administration of justice and is consistent with prior orders of this Court.

This order does not apply to the County of San Mateo offices located on the fourth floor (District Attorney's Office) or sixth floor (County Counsel's Office) of the Hall of Justice and Records, to persons who are going to or coming from those offices in connection with the business of either of those offices, or to County employees who are providing facilities services at any of the locations specified in this order. This Order shall supersede Standing Order 09-102 issued on June 29, 2009.
